

About Project CrossWalk

“Sharing Christ through Works of Love and Words of Truth”.

Project CrossWalk (PCW) is a new and fresh approach to sharing Christ in our community:

- *All volunteer (local grass-roots)*
- *Christian-based*
- *Non-profit ... Incorporated (in State of Texas)*
- *Non-denominational ... encourages involvement of all Christ-based churches*
- *On-going, year-round ministry*

*The **PCW Purpose** is to help the needy and to open doors for sharing the Gospel, through the love and outreach of the local church.*

*The **PCW Plan** is to identify, assess and prioritize home, yard or car repair needs in the community, and align local churches (that want to help and have the skills) with those needs.*

The churches can then share the Gospel in their own way (we post a list of the essential points to make on our website, for consistency).

*The **PCW Process** (how to make this happen) is as follows:*

1. *People with needs contact PCW through phone, email, or PO box.*
2. *PCW sends a Project Screener to explain the PCW process, to assess and prioritize the need, to plan the work, and to pray with the person(s). The Screener will also leave him (or her) a handout or CD that summarizes the Gospel message, explaining that a church group (or other volunteer group) will adopt the project at some later date, and will share more at that time.*
3. *Through the use of an interactive website (<http://www.projectcrosswalk.org/>), PCW will post summaries of projects, listed by Project Number, with brief descriptions of the work, skill sets needed, number of volunteers needed, estimated work times and photos.*
4. *When a church or other volunteer group sees a project it may want to adopt, it contacts PCW for the details.*
5. *If PCW determines the group and the need are a match, and if the group agrees to pray with the persons, leave them a Bible (if they don't have one), share about how to know God through Jesus Christ, and invite them to a church, then the project is handed over to the group, with all the details.*
6. *The church or work group is responsible for the entire project, including materials purchase, repair work, and Project Completion Form. Funds for the materials purchase will be covered by either the homeowner, the work group (if they are able), or PCW (from donations).*
7. *PCW will enter the data from the Project Completion Form when the job is complete.*
